I would say that four times, one each symbolically in an English, Welsh, Scottish, and Northern Irish accent, slowly descending to my knees, then use 24 of my remaining 28 words to invite him to where I live, to see some of the evidence for himself. I would reserve four words for 'Thank you very much', in the belief that a bit of politeness never goes astray.
